As a presenter, Tohby has shared his insights and experience with audiences of all ages throughout Australia and overseas.

FAYE WILSON has spent a decades-long career as a professional illustrator and a teacher of illustration. Her recent projects include the creation of *Blume Illustrated*, a features magazine dedicated to illustration; two ground-breaking group shows of illustration at the Blue Mountains Cultural Centre, *Black and Blue* and *Black and Blue II*; and directing the Blume Illustration Festival, held in Katoomba in 2018. Faye's session will be drawing on her vast experience and knowledge of illustration.
